THE RELEVANCE OF DISCOURSE ANALYSIS

- A focus on what people accomplish in talk, text and interaction
- Discourse analysis brings to the surface underlying expectations and presuppositions
 - → Exposes what is generally regarded as desirable, normal, inappropriate,...
- Narratives as crucial tools with which people articulate their expectations and understandings of their surrounding (future) worlds
- Society as made up of "intricate webs of expectations that human actors cast into the future" (Bell, 2003: 160)
- The future as a discursive domain of struggle and contestation

THE RELEVANCE OF DISCOURSE ANALYSIS

- How are futures discursively articulated and constructed?
- Discourse analysis can strengthen futures studies and vice versa
 - → Discourse analysis brings with it a social constructionist framework that allows to account for the ways people locally make sense of their present *and* future realities
 - → Futures studies does not back away from mapping out alternative directions and paying attention to how 'normativity' might change or alter


TIME HORIZON 2035

WHICH POSSIBLE FUTURES CAN RECREATIONISTS IMAGINE ABOUT THEIR LEISURE ACTIVITIES AND LEISURE EXPERIENCES IN 2035?

GOALS

- Using participative and co-creative methods to draw an overall picture of the wishes, needs and expectations of recreationists in relation to spending and experiencing leisure in 2035
- Providing Pasar with insights on the bottom-up understandings of their (potential) users, facilitating them in the development of future-oriented actions, and nurturing their long-term effectiveness as a sociocultural leisure organisation








RESEARCH OUTCOMES

- The future of leisure seems to be situated within its plurality and complexity as already holds for leisure in general
- Leisure organisations such as Pasar can act upon the unpredictability of the future or upon the possibility of alternative futures
- The formulated preferable images of the future in the form of narratives as a source of inspiration and as potential bedrock for Pasar's future actions
- Allows Pasar to prepare their actions in ways that meet the (future) needs and expectations of its members

- Leisure as a concept in transformation
- Relevance of reframing leisure within a futures discourse
- Allows for anticipation in the present and preparation for the future
- Outcomes are in itself thoroughly contingent, but can help in giving meaning to actions and policy decisions/strategies
- Follow-up: new case studies with sociocultural organizations to underpin validity of the argument
